

**THE TANGANYIKA (LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL)  
AMENDMENT ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1945.**

**AT THE COURT AT BUCKINGHAM PALACE,  
THE 30<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 1945.**

*Present*

**THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS** His Majesty has accepted a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations in respect of the Tanganyika Territory:

**AND WHEREAS** by the Tanganyika (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1926 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order"), as amended by the Tanganyika (Legislative Council) Amendment Order in Council, 1935 (hereinafter referred to as "the Amending Order") and by the Tanganyika (Legislative Council) Amendment Order in Council, 1937, provision is made for the constitution of a Legislative Council in and for the Tanganyika Territory:

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to make other provision than in the said Orders is contained in regard to the constitution of the said Legislative Council:

**NOW, THEREFORE,** His Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1890, or otherwise in His Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of his Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:-

Title and construction.

I. This Order may be cited as the Tanganyika (Legislative Council) Amendment Order in Council, 1945, and shall be construed as one with the Principal Order, as amended by the Amending Order and the Principal Order, the Amending Order and this Order may be cited together as the Tanganyika (Legislative Council) Orders in Council, 1926 to 1945.

Replacement of Clause V of Principal Order.

II. Clause Five of the Principal Order is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything lawfully done thereunder, and the following Clause substituted therefor:-

"Constitution of Legislative Council"

"V. The Council shall consist of the Governor as President, 15 Official Members and not more than 14 Unofficial Members."
